I hope this message finds you well. My name is David Medeiros, a whistleblower and advocate for individuals with disabilities. As a brain injury survivor and founder of ABI Resources, I have uncovered significant systemic failures within Medicaid and other federally funded programs in Connecticut. These failures involve financial mismanagement, harm to vulnerable populations, and violations of federal laws such as the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Key Issues

1. Mismanagement of Federal Medicaid Funds:

I respectfully request guidance and support to ensure my safety as I continue to advocate for justice.

Why This Matters

These systemic issues harm vulnerable populations, misuse taxpayer funds, and erode public confidence in government oversight. Immediate action is necessary to ensure accountability and to uphold principles of justice, equity, and transparency.

My Request

I am reaching out to seek your assistance in addressing these urgent concerns. Specifically, I request:

1. Guidance on how to ensure these issues are escalated appropriately to the relevant Congressional committees.
2. Support in protecting whistleblower rights and ensuring my safety as I continue to advocate for justice.

Proof and Evidence

To support these claims, I have included a ZIP file containing thousands of documents as evidence. This includes:

- Financial data showing Medicaid fund irregularities.
- Documentation of ADA violations.
- Records of whistleblower retaliation and systemic barriers.
- FOIA requests and responses highlighting transparency failures.

I trust that your team will handle this evidence with the seriousness it deserves and ensure it is reviewed thoroughly.
