I am David Medeiros the founder and director of ABI Resources LLC and the whistleblower who filed the original 2023 Whistleblower Report 2024 Federal Intervention Report and 2026 Olmstead Civil Rights Complaint concerning systemic Medicaid fraud waste abuse and Olmstead violations in Connecticut Acquired Brain Injury ABI Waiver and Money Follows the Person MFP programs. I am reporting an appearance of organizational conflict of interest OCI in the handling of my

whistleblower complaint by the Northeastern Unified Program Integrity Contractor NE UPIC. This also involves denial of ADA reasonable accommodations due to my Acquired Brain Injury TBI.

On March 25 2026 I received an email from Eric M. Bischof Project Coordinator SafeGuard Services LLC Peraton the official NE UPIC contractor for CMS. Mr. Bischof stated that the UPIC had been asked to review my concerns about fraud in the Connecticut Medicaid ABI Waiver program. His contact information and office address are listed in the email Suite 200 1250 Camp Hill Bypass Camp Hill PA 17011. The full email is posted on my dedicated evidence page.

The address provided by Mr. Bischof is the exact same physical building as Gainwell Technologies Suite 100 1250 Camp Hill Bypass Camp Hill PA 17011. Gainwell Technologies is the official fiscal agent and claims processor for the entire Connecticut Medical Assistance Program CMAP including the interChange Medicaid Management Information System MMIS that processes all ABI Waiver and MFP claims that are the subject of my fraud allegations. Gainwell has also sent me official CMAP E-Delivery Alerts including one dated March 26 2026 the day after Mr. Bischofs email.

I discovered this conflict on March 26 2026 when I searched the address on Google Maps and confirmed the shared building with public records and screenshots. Annotated screenshots the full Bischof email and todays Gainwell email are all posted on the dedicated page <https://www.david-medeiros.com/2026-upic-safeguard-gainwell-conflict-of-interest->

This creates a clear appearance of organizational conflict of interest because the contractor responsible for investigating fraud in Connecticut Medicaid claims is physically co-located in the same building as the company that actually processes and pays those same claims. The risk of improper influence informal data sharing or impaired objectivity is obvious and unavoidable. This also violates my rights to ADA reasonable accommodations for my TBI. This violates Federal Acquisition Regulation FAR Subpart 9.5 organizational conflicts of interest 42 CFR 455.238 Medicaid integrity contractor independence requirements CMS Medicaid Program Integrity Manual requirements for UPIC impartiality and Olmstead civil rights requirements.

Due to my Acquired Brain Injury TBI I formally request all communication in writing only and all reasonable accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act ADA.

I respectfully request that the DOJ 1.

Immediately investigate this apparent OCI involving SafeGuard Services LLC Peraton and Gainwell Technologies. 2. Review the full evidence on my public site for the underlying Medicaid fraud and Olmstead violations.
