Dear Mr. Bischof,

I have already reported the full matter including the apparent organizational conflict of interest between SafeGuard Services LLC / Peraton (NE UPIC) and Gainwell Technologies directly to the federal authorities on March 26, 2026:

HHS Office of Inspector General, DOJ Civil Rights Division, and FBI Public Corruption.

SafeGuard Services LLC / Peraton is a private contractor, not federal law enforcement. I therefore request that you and your leadership immediately self-report and escalate this organizational conflict of interest to HHS-OIG, CMS, and DOJ for independent review.

Due to my Acquired Brain Injury (TBI), I can only communicate in writing. Pursuant to the Whistleblower Protection Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act, please cease all direct contact with me and direct any future communications exclusively to the federal agencies listed above.

Good morning, Mr. Medeiros,

I am contacting you regarding a complaint we received involving potential fraud, waste, and abuse in Connecticut Medicaid Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) waiver program. I work for SafeGuard Services LLC, and we are the Northeastern Unified Program Integrity Contractor (NE UPIC) for CMS. We have been asked to review some of the concerns you raise. Please know that through our statement of work (SOW) with CMS and federal statute we are limited into what we can review. But it appears that the Federal Government is taking your concerns seriously.

To ensure we are able to efficiently and appropriately evaluate the information within our scope, we are focusing on specific situations where you have direct, firsthand knowledge of services provided or billed. This allows us to assess the information accurately and determine whether further review is warranted, in that it falls within our scope of work.

At this time, we are requesting additional detail regarding specific incidents you personally observed or were directly involved in. General concerns or secondhand information are difficult to evaluate without a clear factual basis tied to a particular event. We can either discuss this with you through a phone call or secure e-mail correspondence, whichever method you prefer. Please contact me at the number below or reply to this e-mail at your earliest convenience.
