I am submitting this formal referral/request for review concerning the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Office for Civil Rights handling of OCR Transaction CU-26-656216.

2. My full formal demand letter sent today at 11:25 AM requesting supervisory review, reasonable accommodation due to traumatic brain injury, specific written explanation of closure, FOIA/Privacy Act case-file production, expedited processing, fee waiver, and record preservation.

OCR's closure letter states that OCR reviewed my December 18, 2025 complaint against Guardiantrac, LLC DBA GT Independence and will not investigate, but it does not identify which allegations were reviewed, which civil-rights statutes or regulations were evaluated, or the jurisdictional, factual, procedural, or legal basis for closing the matter.

I request appropriate review, referral, investigation, or oversight action within your authority. This matter involves disability-access issues, Section 504/ADA/Olmstead concerns, Medicaid ABI Waiver service-access barriers, contractor/fiscal-intermediary accountability, possible retaliation/interference connected to protected complaint activity, and the need to preserve the federal civil-rights record.
